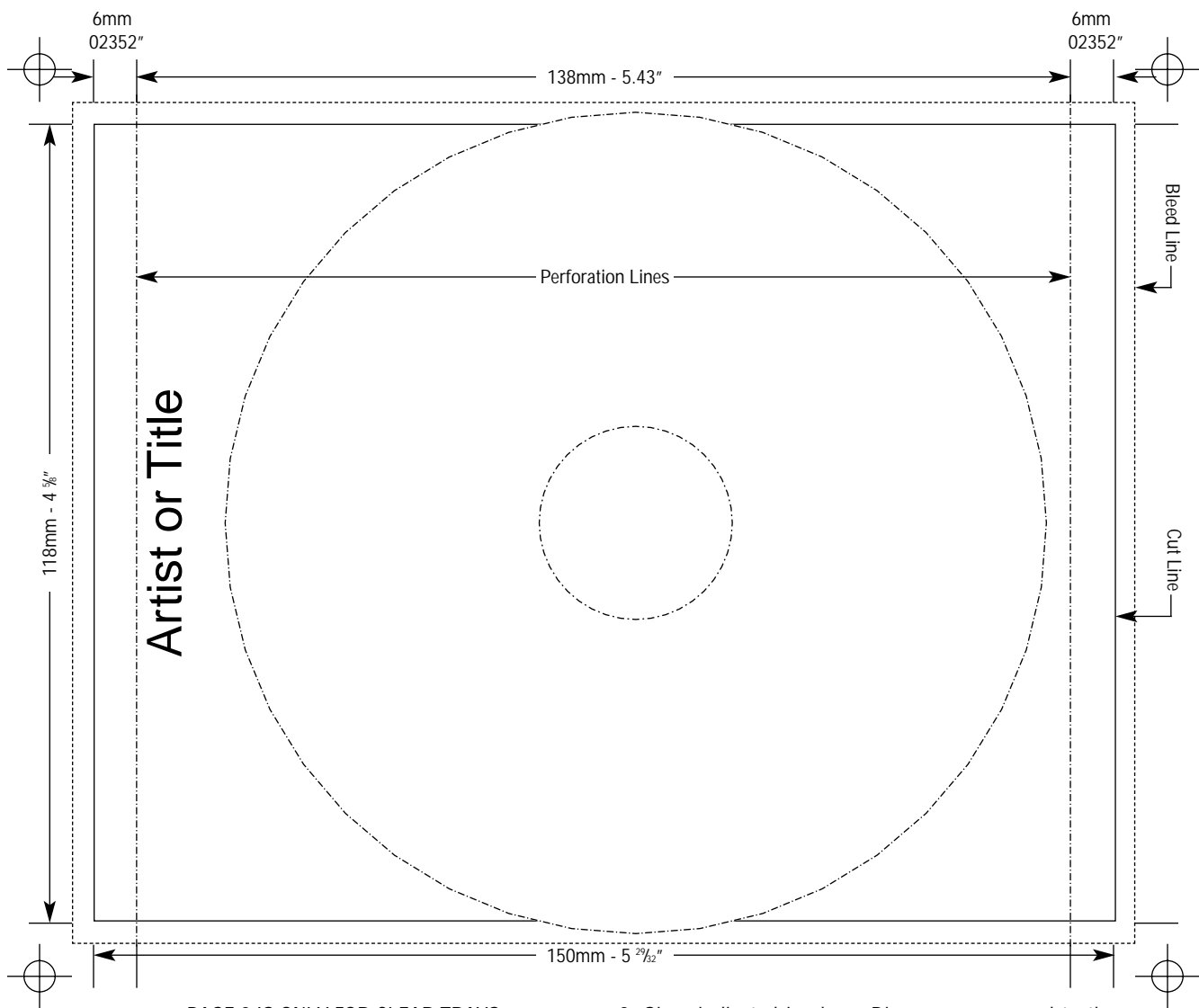


1. Dotted area around layout contains room for any artwork necessary, plus $\frac{1}{8}$ " bleed for cutting (solid-line).
2. Where "Artist" and "Title" are, this text is in the correct orientation to the back. We also need the CD number, as "FR101D" in 6pt. Helvetica Bold.
3. Sizes indicated in above Diagram correspond to the final product and must be rigorously respected
4. For proper automated insertion, traycards must be perforated on both sides, at 6mm or .2352" from the edges as shown. Scoring is not acceptable.
5. The ideal thickness is 100lb.-200M
6. Tray cards received that do not respect Sound Recorders' specifications will incur additional costs.



PAGE 2 IS ONLY FOR CLEAR TRAYS

1. Dotted area around layout contains room for any artwork necessary, plus $\frac{1}{8}$ " bleed for cutting (solid-line).
2. "Artist or Title" shows the area from the perforation that will show through the spine of the clear tray for Artist or Album name. The area is $\frac{3}{8}$ " from perforation.
3. Sizes indicated in above Diagram correspond to the final product and must be rigorously respected
4. Outer circle indicates area of print that is underneath the actual cd, which will be the clearest to see. Inner circle will be obscured by tray center (the thing that holds the disk in place).
